

Wyoming man creates new ice cream flavor

WYOMING – Graeter's unveiled a new ice cream flavor Saturday – Elena's Blueberry Pie – the sale of which will benefit The Cure Starts Now Foundation, a nonprofit that aids pediatric brain cancer research.

It was founded by Brooke and Keith Desserich of Wyoming, whose 6-year-old daughter Elena died of a brain-stem tumor last August.
